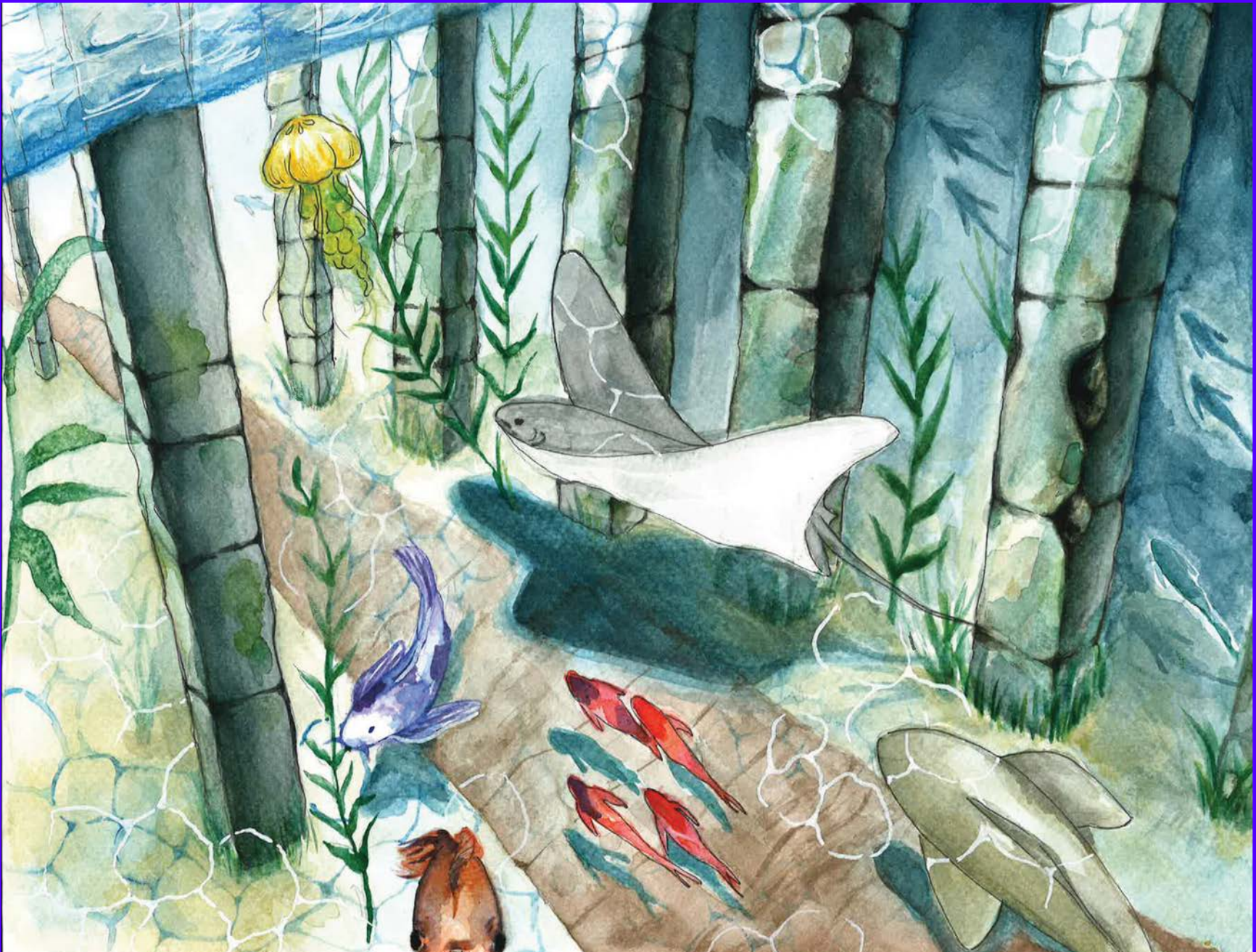



Tips for At Home Water Conservation

Washing Machine

- Wait until you have a full load of laundry before running the machine to save water and energy.
- The average family can save up to 700 gallons of water per month by running full loads in the washing machine.
- Be sure to adjust the water level for each load.
- Set up an appliance maintenance check-up every 3 - 4 years to ensure the performance efficiency of your washing machine.
- When in the market for a new washing machine, be sure to research high-efficiency models. These machines use an average of 30% less water and 50% less energy.

Toilets

- More water is used to flush the toilet than any other purpose in the home.
- Never use your toilet as a trash can!
- Check toilets for leaks at least twice each year. Place a few drops of food coloring in the tank to check for leaks. Wait 10 minutes without flushing, and check the bowl. If color appears in the bowl, you have a leak.
- Remember that not all toilet leaks are noisy; many are silent. A leaking toilet can waste hundreds of gallons of water each day.
- Most toilet leaks are the result of a damaged flapper and can be easily remedied with a new, inexpensive flapper.
- Installing a WaterSense-labeled toilet will significantly lower water and sewer bills.

Kitchen

- Washing dishes accounts for most of the water usage in the kitchen.
- Operate dishwashers only when fully loaded to save on hot water, detergent, and energy costs.
- By using the short cycle instead of the full cycle on your dishwasher, you can save 5 gallons of water per load.
- Instead of pre-rinsing dishes before putting them in the dishwasher, scrape food scraps into the trash can.
- If you need to hand-wash dishes, do not leave the tap running while you scrub.

Showers and Tubs

- Dripping showerheads can waste hundreds of gallons of water each week, depending on the size of the drip.
- Worn-out rubber washers are the main cause of leaks in dripping showerheads. Replacing a showerhead washer is a simple and effective fix.
- Take shorter showers to use less water. Reducing your shower time by just one minute can save 2 - 6 gallons of water per shower.
- The typical showerhead allows a water flow of 5 gallons per minute. Installing a WaterSense-labeled showerhead can reduce this flow by more than 50%.
- When taking a bath, fill the bathtub only halfway and save 15 gallons of water.

Bathroom Faucets

- Bathroom faucets use 2 - 7 gallons of water per minute.
- Always turn off the water while brushing your teeth and washing your hands.
- Install a high-efficiency faucet aerator with a restrictor to reduce flow by 25%.
- Remember to clean the aerator routinely to remove any obstructing particles collected in the screen.
- Fix leaks immediately. A small drip can cause up to 15 gallons of water per day or 105 gallons of water per week to be wasted. That adds up to wasting over 5,000 gallons of water every year!

Outdoor Tips

- Irrigate before 10am or after 4pm, when water loss due to evaporation and wind is minimized, and the ground is the most receptive to water.
- Adjust your sprinkler system heads so they are watering plant material and not directed at the pavement.
- Plants with similar water needs should be grouped together.
- Water plants thoroughly once per week rather than multiple times a week to encourage deeper root growth.
