Electronic bids will be received via Bid Express at www.bidexpress.com on behalf of the Cobb County Board of Commissioners, **until 12:00 noon August 13, 2026. NO BIDS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE 12:00 NOON DEADLINE.** No submitted bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled bid opening for a period of ninety (90) days.

All bids shall be accompanied by an Electronic Bid Bond via Bid Express a Paper Bid Bond, or a Certified Check delivered in a sealed envelope, indicating the project name and project number, to Cobb County Procurement Services Department, 1828 West Oak Parkway, Marietta, GA, 30062, BEFORE THE 12:00 NOON DEADLINE. Bid Bond shall be drawn in favor of the Board of Commissioners, Cobb County, Georgia, in the amount of five percent (5%) of the bid for the complete work.

Proposals may be rejected if any of the Unit Prices are obviously unbalanced. The County will decide whether any Unit Prices are unbalanced either excessively above or below a reasonable cost analysis value determined by the Engineer, particularly if these unbalanced amounts are substantial and contrary to the interest on the County.

In an effort to meet Title VI requirements, contractors are encouraged to fill out the form in the bid package. This is strictly voluntary. Please place form in a separate envelope and deliver to Cobb County Purchasing Department.

I. PREBID CONFERENCE

Minutes of the Prebid Conference held on Tuesday, August 4, 2026, are attached.

II. QUESTIONS/ANSWERS

- Q. Is nighttime work allowed on this project? If so, is it available on all roads and what are the hours for such?
- A. **Yes, night work will be allowed on the following roads between the hours of 7:00 pm and 6:00 am: Poplar Springs Road, Wright Road, Jamerson Road (Shallowford Rd – Canton Rd), Florence Road, and River View Road.**
- Q. What is the required depth for patching?
- A. **Typical patching depth is 2" but could be more pending evaluation of the underlying surface.**
- Q. Can we use temporary advance warning signs throughout the project?
- A. **The advanced warning signs can be placed on tripods as long as properly maintained.**
- Q. The schedule of values appear to be broken into three different sections as there are 3 Construction Allowance and 3 Traffic Control pay items as well as duplicates of other items such as asphalt and striping. Can you explain how this is broken out and which items belong with which streets?
- A. **The 3 different groups are as follows: 1. Resurfacing of roads in unincorporated Cobb County (Line Items 5-150); 2. ADA Ramp Upgrades in advance of resurfacing Line Items 155-230); and 3. Resurfacing of roads within the City of Mableton (Line Items 235-330).**
- Q. Can you provide detail on the Pull Box relocation requirements?
- A. **This item is for the adjustment to grade for any Traffic Signal Pull Boxes located within the limits of the reconstructed ADA ramp. This is an As Directed item. The County does not anticipate any PB adjustments for the roads in this contract.**
- Q. Are all side roads to be included in resurfacing?
- A. **Resurfacing of side roads to the back of radius is typically included. Actual limits to be determined in the field.**

II. QUESTIONS/ANSWERS (continued)

Q. What are the requirements for the Railroad on River View Road?

A. **No resurfacing is included within 50' of the RR tracks. Contactor shall coordinate with RR owner for flagging protection, if needed, whenever Contractor or their equipment is, or are likely to be, within fifty (50) feet of track (includes moving equipment across RR track).**

Q. In the pre bid meeting, my question about how the SOV was set up was answered. It was explained that the first section was the Cobb county roads, the second is for ADA ramps, and the third for city of Mableton roads. However, the pay item for ADA ramps is included in the first section and the second section include pay items for sidewalks, curb and gutter, Class B widening, ect. There are no details for anything in the second section. Can you provide details/locations and explain what the intent of these items are or remove this section from the SOV?

A. **The 3 different groups are as follows: 1. Resurfacing of roads in unincorporated Cobb County (Line Items 5-150); 2. ADA Ramp Upgrades in advance of resurfacing Line Items 155-230); and 3. Resurfacing of roads within the City of Mableton (Line Items 235-330).**

Q. What is the paving expectation for the driveways and side roads along the mainline?

A. **Resurfacing of side roads to the back of radius is typically included. Actual limits to be determined in the field. No resurfacing is anticipated for driveways.**

Q. What are the allowable work hours for this project?

A. **As stated in Section 150.3.01 - Contractor shall not install lane closures, pace traffic or move equipment or materials between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Monday through Friday; and 6:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Sunday, during times when school is in session.**

When school is not in session, the Contractor shall not install lane closures, pace traffic or move equipment or materials between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Monday through Friday; and 6:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Sunday.

Q. When will the NTP be issued?

A. **Award of contract anticipated for September 2026. NTP anticipated in October/November 2026.**

II. QUESTIONS/ANSWERS (continued)

- Q. For the allowance bid items could the unit be changed to "LS"?
- A. No.
- Q. For the ADA ramps, are we replacing only the detectable warning pads, or is the entire ramp, including the concrete, to be removed and replaced?
- A. **Existing ADA ramps are to be removed and reconstructed for ADA compliance unless otherwise noted.**
- Q. Will the bid tab be separated into headers and subtotals to differentiate what the bid items are for?
- A. **See attached Bid Schedule, for informational purposes.**
- Q. What is the width for the shoulder grading/shoulder rehabilitation?
- A. **Varies based on conditions – typical width is 2-3 feet.**
- Q. Is the 19mm to be placed on turn lanes and travel lanes?
- A. **Yes for travel lanes and No for turn lanes and side streets. The typical section of Mill 3.5" then Pave Back 220#-19.0mm + 165#-12.5mm/9.5mm applies to mainline travel lanes only. Typical section for turn lanes and side roads will be to mill and inlay 1-1/2 inches.**
- Q. Are tripod mounted signs allowed for use on this project?
- A. **The advanced warning signs can be placed on tripods as long as properly maintained throughout duration of resurfacing activities.**
- Q. Will any message boards be required on this project?
- A. **Yes. Message boards shall be placed a minimum of 72 hours days in advance of mobilization and shall remain until resurfacing is complete. Boards to be provided by contractor. Cost to be included in price bid for other items.**

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(2) Project Description:

Project consists of asphaltic resurfacing on various county streets, including variable depth milling, patching, pavement markings and pedestrian improvements.

All roads to be completed by September 30, 2027.

Failure to complete the overall construction in accordance with the above will result in the assessment of Liquidated Damages at the rate of \$2,000.00 per consecutive calendar day or portion thereof.

Payment will be made monthly based on approved invoices.

(3) Bid Proposal and Contract Documents:

Pedestrian access shall be maintained at all times.

Contractor shall procure and maintain in full force and effect for the duration of this Agreement, insurance protecting against claims for injuries to persons or damages to property which may arise from or in connection with performance of the Work hereunder by the Contractor, his agents, representatives, employees, or subcontractors. Professional Liability and Builder's "All Risk" coverage will generally not be required on Cobb County Department of Transportation contracts unless specified.

The Contractor must meet the current bid requirements of the Georgia Department of Transportation.

All bidders submitting **bids in excess of \$2,000,000.00** must be prequalified with the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT). All bidders submitting **bids of \$2,000,000.00 or less** shall be registered subcontractors or prequalified with GDOT. Subcontractors must be prequalified or registered with GDOT.

For all bids on contracts involving utility work as defined in O.C.G.A. 43-14-1 et.seq., the **Contractor and/or its subcontractor(s)** that will perform utility work must have a valid State of Georgia Utility Contractor License and comply with all applicable provisions of Chapter 14 of Title 43 of O.C.G.A.

All work performed for this project will be in accordance with the Georgia Department of Transportation Standards and Details; GDOT Standard Specifications Construction of Transportation Systems, **2021 Edition**; all Georgia Department of Transportation Construction Standards and Details are applicable unless otherwise noted and any modifications identified in the bid documents.

The Contractor and their subcontractors are required to be in compliance with the "Georgia Security and Immigration Compliance Act." The Contractor must execute and submit at the time of the bid the "Contractor Affidavit and Agreement," or bid will be determined non-responsive and will be disqualified.

The Cobb County, Georgia, Department of Transportation in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and 78 Stat. 252, 42 USC 2000d—42 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, part 21, Nondiscrimination in federally assisted programs of the Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, sex, national origin, disability, or age in consideration for an award.

Failure to comply with any of the requirements and procedures of the County (i.e., failure to timely supply required affidavits or compliance certification documents; failure to utilize federal work authorization procedures; failure to permit or facilitate audits or reviews of records by County officials upon request; and/or failure to continue to meet any of the statutory or County obligations during the life of the contract) shall constitute a material breach of the agreement and shall entitle the County to dismiss any general contractor or to require the dismissal of any subcontractor or sub/subcontractor (irrespective of tier) for failing to fully comply with these requirements, and

All bidders must be on record with Bid Express as being plan holders. All bids shall be submitted electronically through Bid Express at www.bidexpress.com. Paper bids will not be accepted.

That upon notice of a material breach of these provisions, the Contractor (or subcontractor, regardless of tier) shall be entitled to cure the breach within ten (10) days and provide evidence of such cure. Should the breach not be cured, the County shall be entitled to all available remedies, including termination of the contract, the requirement that a subcontractor be dismissed from performing work under the contract, and any and all damages permissible by law.

In accordance with, 49 CFR Part 26.11 requires Cobb County Department of Transportation to develop and maintain a “bid opportunity list”. The list is intended to be a listing of all firms participating or attempting to participate, on Federally Funded projects, including both DBEs and non-DBEs.

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(4) Utility Issues:

For all bids for contracts involving utility work as defined in O.C.G.A. 43-14-1 et.seq., the Contractor and/or subcontractor(s) that will perform utility work must have a valid state of Georgia Utility Contractor License and comply with all applicable provisions of Chapter 14 of title 43 of O.C.G.A.

Contractor shall submit monthly reports of utility coordination correspondence.

It is the Contractor's responsibility to coordinate all utility relocations.

Utility delays due to lack of coordination on behalf of the contractor will not be considered for reprieve from liquidated damages. This project is considered by the UPC to be a large ticket item.

(5) Right-of-Way:

All right of way has been acquired.

(6) Special Items to Note:

There are two bid items with a fixed cost - Construction allowance and Utility allowance. These items will only be used at the discretion of the Construction Project Engineer with approval by the County Construction Engineer.

All walls shall have an ashlar finish with anti-graffiti coating, cost to be included in price of concrete.

All storm drain shall be R.C.P., only pipe under driveways may be per GDOT selection chart.

All signs that are temporarily removed must be put back in place before the end of the day.

Trees outside of construction limits are to be removed only as directed by the Engineer.

If required the Contractor shall take three-point levels on Widening and Reconstruction Projects and obtain the Engineer's approval of the "best fit" profile and cross slope, to minimize leveling requirements of the existing roadway. The Contractor must get the Engineer's approval of the proposed best fit before beginning widening and reconstruction. This will also apply to all walls, contractor shall layout walls before constructing them to get Engineers approval.

Grass shall be replaced in kind to match existing prior to construction. Sod shall be replaced with sod, seeded grass shall be replaced with seed. There is a pay item for sod to be used in yards and beauty strip. Included in the sod pay item is ground preparation and 4-inches of topsoil.

Contractor will be required to mow grass no less than once a month until final acceptance.

All materials will come from the Georgia Department of Transportation Qualified Products List.

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(6) Special Items to Note: (continued)

For asphaltic concrete pavement, placement of thermoplastic striping may commence no sooner than a minimum of 15 calendar days, and must be completed within a maximum of 45 calendar days following completion of the final surface course. If incomplete, liquidated damages in the amount of \$1,000 per day will apply.

- **No work shall be performed by the Contractor on any County project between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., Monday through Saturday, unless specifically authorized by the County. Contractor shall adhere to the Cobb County Noise Ordinance which prohibits loud or unusual noise between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. Any work performed during these hours will result in the assessment of Non-Refundable Deduction at the rate of \$1,000.00/hr or portion of an hour. These damages are in addition to any other specified damages as per Section 108.08, Failure or Delay in Completing Work on Time, or otherwise stated elsewhere in the Contract Documents.**

The contractor shall be required to repair or replace any existing parking lots within or adjacent to provided easements if used by and damaged by the contractor or any sub-contractors working for the contractor.

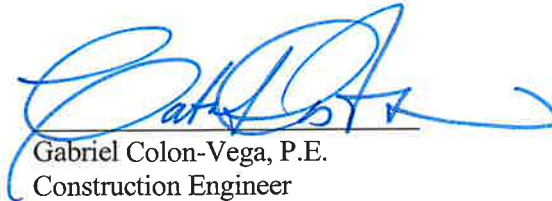
